Article 35 - Data Protection Impact Assessment

Whenever there is a new project/service involving the use of personal information, then a data protection risk assessment must be undertaken. This process is known as the data protection impact assessment (DPIA). We publish a summary of all DPIAs our public website.

Completing a DPIA is not a one-off exercise. It is regarded as a working document and it will remain active until the termination of the service/system. When this is a significant change in the service/system, the DPIA should be updated to reflect the change and the change of risk.
