

Article 20 – Right to data portability

The Right to data portability means a person can request to receive personal information concerning them in a transferrable electronic format, so that the information can easily be transmitted or shared by the person. The person can also request us to transmit the personal data to another organisation where it is technically feasible.

The right only applies to data processed on the basis of consent or on a contract, and which is processed by automatic means. This is generally not applicable to health care as we are using the lawful basis of “performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority”.
