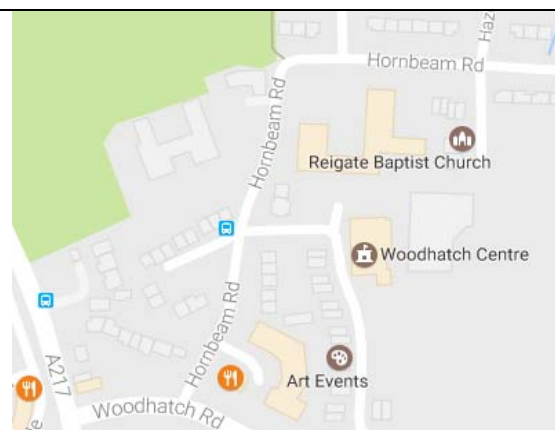
5. People Participation & Experience Team (30 mins)

FoCUS Area Group Meeting Ground Rules

- Phones to be switched to silent at the beginning of a meeting (unless agreed otherwise with the meeting facilitator).
- Those attending meetings should arrive on time, as often as possible.
- Think about what you are going to say and how you are going to say it. FoCUS can take forward concerns and compliments on services but cannot resolve individual concerns. Keep in mind the objectives of FoCUS and that information will be shared publicly.
- Give other people the time and opportunity to speak. Do not talk over someone, wait until it is your turn.
- Value and respect people's contribution and their confidentiality, accepting people have different views.
- Provide a supportive environment to give everyone the same opportunities.
- If the meeting rules are not being met, the facilitator can call a short break or if the group has agreed to use cards, members will raise their cards to indicate their discomfort.
