

## Article 21 - Right to Object

A person who uses our services, a carer or an employee can object the way we use and/or share their personal information. This is applicable to any data processed for the purpose of the Trust's public functions or in the exercise of its official authority.

However, this is exempt if we can give compelling reasons for the continuation of the use and sharing of the personal information which override the interests of the person or the Trust, when processing legal claims. For anyone requests the Right to Object, the person will be invited to discuss the requirements with us.
